For the Parent:

In chapter 14 your child learned to:

- Evaluate choices made
- Make a personal examination of conscience
- Determine ways to make up for wrongdoing

There is a basic conviction in all people of good will that certain behaviors are right or wrong. They search for and promote justice, truth, and fidelity. They refrain from dishonesty, idolatry, and the taking of innocent life. Believers listen to God's voice in determining the rightness or wrongness of their attitudes and behaviors. They recognize that the ability to choose what is right depends on listening carefully God's voice as God speaks through Scripture, Tradition, Church teaching, life experience, and the examples of the saints and other people of faith.
